



## NEWLY BUILT RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS AND DWELLINGS COMPLETED IN THE FOURTH QUARTER OF 2024 (PRELIMINARY DATA)

According to preliminary data<sup>1</sup> from the National Statistical Institute, in the fourth quarter of 2024, the number of newly built residential buildings was 1 378, and the newly built dwellings in them were 5 192.

In the fourth quarter of 2024, 78.0% of the newly built residential buildings had steelconcrete construction, 18.1% had solid structure, 3.6% had 'other' and 0.3% had a panel construction. The highest is the relative share of newly built houses (76.6%), followed by blocks of flats (15.7%).

The highest is the number of residential buildings built in Sofia (stolitsa) district - 190 residential buildings with 1 566 dwellings, followed by Plovdiv district - 182 residential buildings with 521 dwellings, and Varna district - 165 buildings with 562 dwellings in them (Figure 1).

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The highest is the number of newly built dwellings with two rooms (39.6%), followed by the number of those with three rooms (31.0%), and the lowest is the number of dwellings with five rooms (5.5%) (Figure 2).

In the fourth quarter of 2024, the total useful space of the newly built dwellings was 491.8 thousand sq. m, and the living floor space was 369.8 thousand square meters.

The **average useful floor** space of a newly built dwelling was 94.7 square meters.

The largest average useful floor space of a newly built dwelling was recorded in the districts of Sofia - 161.9 sq. m, and Smolyan - 160.1 sq. m, and the smallest ones in Vratsa - 56.0 sq. m, and Pleven - 66.1 square meters.

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#### **Methodological notes**

The statistical data about the newly built residential buildings and dwellings are prepared based on quarterly reports of the municipal administrations.

In the scope of the survey are newly built residential buildings with approved or valid usage licenses according to Regulation No. 2/31.07.2003 of the Ministry of Regional Development and Public Works.

**Living floor space** includes rooms and kitchens with over 4 sq. m of floor space.

**Service floor space** is the floor space of rooms and kitchens with less than 4 square meters of floor space, vestibules with a portal or other screen, corridors, bathrooms, toilets, larders, hanging closets and other service rooms, such as drying rooms, laundries or balconies regardless of their space.

**The useful floor space** of the dwelling is the sum of the living floor space and the service floor space.

**The average useful floor space** is the ratio between the useful floor space and the number of dwellings.
